6. Downtown Atlanta's experience for visitors and residents has diminished compared to other communities. What would you do, if elected, to improve the downtown experience?
7. Repeat offenders are a longstanding barrier to a safer Atlanta, not to mention a significant drain on limited judicial resources. What can be done to improve interagency coordination and reduce recidivism rates?
8. What should be the relationship between the business and civic community and City Hall?
9. Fast forward one year. You have been elected and served the remainder of your term in office. How will you and the voters measure your success?
