- 7. Repeat offenders are a longstanding barrier to a safer Atlanta, not to mention a significant drain on limited judicial resources. What can be done to improve interagency coordination and reduce recidivism rates?
- 8. What should be the relationship between the business and civic community and City Hall?
- 9. Fast forward one year. You have been elected and served the remainder of your term in office. How will you and the voters measure your success?
